Overview...

A medium dry matter variety ideally suited to pre-pack production.

- Rich yellow flesh
- Good scab resistance
- Drought tolerant
- Ideal for roasting/chipping

Jelly is a medium to late maincrop variety suitable for both table consumption and French fry production. It produces very high marketable yields of nice, medium to large oval tubers. The variety has a smooth yellow skin finish with pure yellow flesh colour.

Jelly has a high drought tolerance and can be grown on most soil types. It is highly resistant to PV Y and scores well against leaf and tuber blight, blackleg, Rhizoctonia and common scab.
