ROBUST PERFORMANCE GIVING HIGH NET YIELDS

Produces an attractive uniform crop of light yellow tubers, with shallow eyes and a fantastic skin finish.

Early bulking, particularly suitable for a short growing season.

Firm cooking type with excellent taste.

Will benefit from an early blight programme, also ensure proper conditioning out of cold storage to avoid bruising

ADVICE

Do you need specific advice about seed rates, fertilisers or agronomy? Ask your local supplier or Meijer contact.

Avoid strongly chitted seed as chits are liable to break off during planting and severely affect vigour.

It is preferable to break off chits by decanting into boxes and wait for eyes to re-open before planting.

Sensitive to Sencorex (Metribuzin) used at the full dose when applied pre-emergence.

Do not cultivate on common scab prone soils.

Susceptible to Fusarium dry rots.
